#### Before Creating a PDF

- ~~Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact Giovanni Mezzina at [giovanni.mezzina@poliba.it](mailto:giovanni.mezzina@poliba.it) for the appropriate copyright notice.~~
- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

#### *First-time users should do the following:*

1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
2. Enter the following:
  - 46749X for the Conference ID
  - your email address
  - a password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

*Previous users* of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
